And yet the hotel shares Boulder's contemporary, unconventional style and the welcoming and friendly attitude that makes the "People's Republic of Boulder" so beloved. From charming speakeasy License No. 1, to the hotel's award-winning Spruce Farm & Fish and popular local hangout The Corner Bar, Hotel Boulderado is where guests and locals come to hang out, to sip, dine, see and be seen. The lobby is also home to the Boxcar Coffee Bar that serves beer, wine, spirits and small plates under the famous stainedglass atrium ceiling. 10,000 square feet of meeting space make it the ideal place to gather for special celebrations and events. If you want the true Boulder experience, there is only Hotel Boulderado.

**Description:** Turn-of-the-century splendor blends with cordial hospitality at Hotel Boulderado, which opened on New Year's Day 1909 in the heart of historic Boulder. Today they have 160 completely modernized rooms and suites, including 42 that retain a taste of Victorian extravagance. Located just a block from the street performers, outdoor cafés and music of the Pearl Street Mall, Hotel Boulderado is where both guests and locals love to congregate. From the unique rooms of the License No. 1 speakeasy, to the hotel's popular outdoor patio, to the fresh, local cuisine at Spruce Farm & Fish, Hotel Boulderado has stellar dining and drinking options, including lobby cocktail service and the Boxcar Coffee Bar serving local coffee and refreshments. A stunningly beautiful balcony that has hosted thousands of weddings and 10,000-square feet of meeting space top off the experience.

## **Rooms & Suites**

The historic section of the hotel has 42 rooms and suites, each one uniquely appointed in the décor and style of Victorian times. The Historic Wing rooms are also equipped with all the 21st century amenities, yet retain the charm of the era. The 114 rooms in the North Wing were renovated in 2016 following the spirit of the original structure. The North Wing features modern furnishings and contemporary nature-focused artwork that captures the ambience of the West. Large windows offer copious natural light and have sweeping views of Downtown Boulder, the Rocky Mountain foothills, or the Boulder Flatirons. All rooms have premium HD cable, complimentary Wi-Fi, laptop-friendly workstations, high-end bedding, and modern bathrooms with Aveda toiletries, plush Boca bathrobes and 100% cotton bath linens.

**Getting to Hotel Boulderado:** Hotel Boulderado is located at 2115 13th, at the corner of Spruce Street and 13th. From Denver International Airport, exit the airport and proceed on E 86th Ave to Pena Blvd. Keep right to stay on Peña Blvd. Take exit 6B toward Boulder/Ft Collins. Merge onto E470 N (note: this is a toll road). In 17.5 miles keep left to continue on Northwest Pkwy. In 9.4 miles take a slight right toward US-36 W/Denver Boulder turnpike. Merge onto US-36 W. In 9.2 miles take the Canyon Blvd exit. Use the right 2 lanes to turn left on Canyon Blvd. In 1 mile turn right onto Broadway. In half a mile turn right onto Pine St, then turn right onto 13th. The hotel will be on your right. Hotel Boulderado is also within walking distance of the RTD bus. Please visit <a href="www.rtd-denver.com">www.rtd-denver.com</a> to plan your trip via the Route AB bus from Denver International Airport or from Denver's Union Station.
