Spruce Farm & Fish

Open since 2014, Spruce Farm & Fish serves delectable and inspired brunch and dinner cuisine crafted from the highest quality ingredients possible. Executive Chef Mike Thom grew up in Upstate New York with a grandmother that was passionate about cooking and a grandfather who would take him into kitchens to see the inner workings of restaurants. After 30 years as the Director of Culinary for over 250 restaurants across the country, Chef Thom now works at Hotel Boulderado overseeing all the kitchens as Executive Chef for Spruce Farm & Fish, The Corner Bar, License No. 1, and Hotel Boulderado's banquet department. He is passionate about working with his culinary team to elevate dishes with the freshest of seasonal ingredients while making creative twists to classics featuring farm and fish themes. The daily Chefs Specials often feature bold flavors and comforting dishes for lunch and dinner. From decadent brunch dishes to mouthwatering dinner entrées, the kitchen is sure to please the most discerning palates. The Corner Bar

The Corner Bar is well known throughout the city as the place to soak up the sun on its beautiful and sprawling patio in the prime of summer or cheer on the Buffs inside its warm, cordial pub atmosphere in the throes of winter. License No. 1

Proudly still operating under one of the first Restaurant/Bar liquor licenses issued in Boulder after the city's long 60-year prohibition ended in 1969, License No. 1 and its smoldering speakeasy style, serve up some of the best cocktails in the city. License No. 1 specializes in

classic cocktails from the Prohibition Era as well creative concoctions from expert bartenders. Their menu also offers a wide selection of popular spirits, a select wine list and a locally driven 20-tap beer list. Within its seven rooms are two full separate bars, multiple seating areas, and a dance floor. Entertainment offerings include Live Music, Comedy Nights, and a vintage photobooth. Dining options are readily available as the bar offers a happy hour and full dinner menu. Private Event packages and Banquet Catering are also available. License No. 1 is a perfect setting for intimate dates, small private events, and large gatherings.

The Boxcar Coffee Bar

The Boxcar Coffee Bar is located in the lobby of Hotel Boulderado and proudly serves locally-roasted Boxcar Coffee. Guests can enjoy an espresso or cup of Teakoe Tea while lounging in the beautiful lobby, with its early 1900s architecture and resplendent stained-glass ceiling. Start the day with a fresh brewed beverage from the Boxcar Coffee Bar before heading out to the Pearl Street Pedestrian Mall, just a block away, for a little shopping in downtown Boulder. Later in the day, visitors and guests alike come back to finish the day at the bar now transitioned to offer dinner service.
